Instructions for use:

This questionnaire aims to measure the extent to which a range of practices and behaviours related to staff-family relationships are present in this aged care facility. That is, how often do you observe these practices and behaviours?

The questionnaire consists of 25 statements. You are asked to decide to what extent you think each statement is true of this aged care facility. Please put a cross in the box for the alternative that best fits with what you think. It is important that you respond to all the statements.
